

RULES for Children Up to Age 3

1. The activities need to be completed by the infant and an adult or older child.
 2. On your log, mark the date that each activity is completed.
 3. When the 8 activities in a section are finished, bring in your reading log.
 4. PRIZES can be collected on or after the date listed at the top of each section.
