





About the Book — *Present day:* Julia Hamill makes a horrifying discovery on the grounds of her new home in rural Massachusetts: a skull buried in the rocky soil–human, female, and, according to the trained eye of Boston medical examiner Maura Isles, scarred with the unmistakable marks of murder long ago... *Boston, 1830:* to pay for his education, medical student Norris Marshall has joined the ranks of local "resurrectionists"–those who plunder graveyards and harvest the dead for sale on the black market. Norris now finds

himself the prime suspect in a series of grisly murders. Joined by a sardonic young man named Oliver Wendell Holmes, Norris sets out to prove his innocence and track down a maniacal fiend--party of the dark mystery reaching across centuries to the present-day world of Julia Hamill.

Summer Reading Recap

Thank you to everyone that participated in our 2013 Summer Reading Program and a special congratulations to the 1,076 children, teens, and adults that completed the program.

With your help, we beat our reading goals set at the beginning of the summer and as a group, lots of wonderful books were read. Just how many?...

- *Infants:* about 150 of our youngest library patrons completed a total of 2,512 activities.
- Kids: with exactly 1,250 children ages 3-grade 6 participating, the group read for 386,820 minutes.
- *Teens:* our more than 215 teen participants in grades 6-12 read 472,158 pages!
- *Adults:* between the 391 adults participating, there were more than 1,693 books read.

Wow! That's a lot of books! As a reward, younger children that finished the program were entertained by Leonardo (below) at

the SRP party and all other age groups enjoyed parties of their own.




Free MP3 Music
