PRICES

DELAYS

2. All orders shall be subject to delays or failures in manufacturing or in delivery due to labor troubles, accidents, fires damage to or destruction of plants or laboratories, wars, riots, embargoes, Acts of God, governmental regulations or restrictions or an other contingencies beyond the control of the manufacturer or distributor.

PAYMENT

3. If purchaser shall default in any payment or if purchaser's financial conditions shall at any time seem to A-1 DOOR SPECIALTIES, INC. inadequate to warrant further shipments, A-1 DOOR SPECIALTIES, INC. shall have to right to cancel any orders or delay any shipments. Purchaser will be responsible and shall pay all attorneys' fees and court cost resulting from A-1 DOOR SPECIALTIES, INC. attempting to collect any portion of payment described in this Proposal.

SHIPPING

4. On orders that do not contain specific shipping instructions, A-1 DOOR SPECIALTIES, INC. shall have the right to ship, in what is in its opinion, the best way.

SUBSTITUTION

5. A-1 DOOR SPECIALTIES, INC. shall have the right to substitute material where materials specified are not obtainable from the usual sources of supply, whether such condition arises because of raw material or production shortages, priorities or preferences establishes by any governmental authorities or any other reason beyond the control of A-1 DOOR SPECIALTIES, INC. In the event such substitution cannot, in the opinion of A-1 DOOR SPECIALTIES, INC. be conveniently made, A-1 DOOR SPECIALTIES, INC. may cancel any orders involving such equipment or parts thereof.

WAIVERS

6. No modification or waiver of any of the provisions herein contained or any future representation, promise or condition in connection with the subject matter hereof, shall be binding upon A-1 DOOR SPECIALTIES, INC. unless made in writing and signed by a duly authorized officer. A-1 DOOR SPECIALTIES, INC. is not bound by any terms on purchaser's orders, which vary the terms and conditions set forth in this acknowledgment of order. This order acknowledgment shall constitute the entire contract between the parties.

INSTALLATION

7. Where installation is made other than by A-1 DOOR SPECIALTIES, INC. the buyer agrees that installation will be made per manufacturer's instructions. If manufacturer's installation instructions have not been followed, A-1 DOOR SPECIALTIES, INC. will thereby be relieved of any warranty.

CLAIMS

8. The products covered by the order shall be deemed finally inspected and accepted within ten (10) days after receipt thereof unless notice of claim is given in writing to the seller within that period. The seller's liability shall not exceed the replacement value of the defective materials, and no warranties, expressed or implied, or statements or any representation shall extend such liability. Goods returned without our consent will not be accepted.

GUARANTEE

9. Equipment is guaranteed to be free of defects in material and workmanship for a period of one year, normal wear and used excepted, with 90-days guarantee on electrical control components. This guarantee does not apply when damage has been caused by misuse, fire, flood, windstorm, vandalism, or Acts of God.

CANCELLATION

10. A minimum of 50% cancellation fee will apply.
