Free WiFi, Mobile Hotspots, & Computers

Free WiFi is available at both the Main Library in Bluffton and the Ossian Branch. You can also check out mobile hotspots with a library card for up to 7 days at a time (must be done on an adult card by those 18 & up). Computers and iPads are available for internet use, research, word processing, and educational games. Laptop rental is also available in the buildings.

Teacher Resources

The library offers a number of resources that will help in a classroom setting, in addition to our large selection of books, CDs, DVDs/Blu-rays, audio books, audio kits, magazines, Launchpads, and Playaways.
