I am asking for approval to hire 2 full-time summer interns: Lauren Goble and Katelyn Bieberich. The hiring wage for both interns will be \$12.80/hour for 30-36 hours per week. Due to a relabeling project and one additional shift in the Children's Department, we are also asking to hire Cal Grandlienard for 12 hours a week at \$11.53/hour. Cal will mostly be utilized in our Material Services department with the relabeling project but also one evening shift in our Children's Department. His start date will be May 16th.
